
c. Russia - Julia Samoilova has been banned from Ukraine for entering annexed Crimea via Russia. It is likely that she will have to perform via satellite link.













c. for pumping raw sewage into the River Thames on several occasions - The £20.3m fine is the largest penalty handed down to a water utility for an environmental disaster. The spills occurred in 2013 and 2014 at four Thames Water Utilities Ltd sewage treatment works. Hundreds of fish were killed and sewage spilled into nature reserves, while nappies and other debris went into the Thames and the adjoining River Thames.


